Dr. Inciong is actively involved in surgical training being part of the training committee of the St Luke's Medical Center's Institute of Surgery and as Co-Chair of the Committee on Surgical Training of the Philippine College of Surgeons (PCS). Highly motivated in the academe, he is an Associate Professor in Surgery at St. Luke's Medical Center - College of Medicine and is involved in the evaluation of graduates of surgical training programs at the Philippine Board of Surgery (PBS).
