Prof Dr Tan Maw Pin is a Geriatric Medicine Professor at the University of Malaya. She received her medical training at the University of Nottingham and obtained a National Training Number in Geriatric Medicine at Newcastle upon Tyne, UK after passing her MRCP. Prof Dr Tan is an active academic researcher and is currently the Principal Investigator of two research projects, namely the Promoting Independence in our Seniors with Arthritis (PISA) Grand Challenge and the Malaysian Falls Assessment and Intervention Trial (MyFAIT). She was a co-investigator of the Malaysian Elders Longitudinal Research (MELoR) study and is now leading the nationwide longitudinal study of ageing called the AGELESS study, which is funded by the Ministry of Education. She is an academic editor for Plos One and an associate editor for Frontiers in Medicine. Dr Tan continues to practice geriatrics at the University of Malaya Medical Centre and has established the Falls and Syncope Service at the University of Malaya. She also chairs the hospital inpatient falls committee.
